Teen-Ager May Pitch Saturday

Reds' Nolan 'Feels Fine'

Two pitchers, separated by 20 years in age but joined by a common distinction of playing as teenagers on the Reds, met in the dugout at Crosley Field Monday.

A slap on the back, a gentle nudge in the ribs and an exchange of "good luck" marked the meeting of Joe Nuxhall, now a sports announcer, and Gary Nolan, hoping to pitch in his first game for the Reds Saturday.

If he makes it Saturday, Nolan, who is 18, will become the second youngest pitcher ever to go to the mound for the Reds. Nuxhall did the trick when he was 15—pitching two thirds of an inning on June 18, 1941. Eight years later, after an apprenticeship in the minors, Joe joined the Reds' varsity squad.

"I played little league, high school and American Legion ball in my home town, Oroville, Calif.," young Nolan said. "I was all good habits in little league."

"I've been pitching ever since I was seven, when my parents gave me a ball and a glove."

Nolan was pitching for his high school team, "and getting clean-up when I was in there," only a year ago. He was scouted at the school and picked up by the Reds in the June draft last year. "I don't think they'll pitch me in relief," he said in the dugout. "I think I'll get in the rotation, and there's a possibility I'll work Saturday."

A reporter noted that Nolan seemed very relaxed, and not a bit frightened at the prospect of the big leagues.

"I feel fine. This makes me very happy," he said. "Of course you always get a little nervous any time you take that little ball out there."

"It's a strange feeling, all this time in the dugout in street clothes," Nolan said. "I've had come from the broadcast booth to greet the team and work with Claude (Schilling) and Jim (McIntyre)." Nolan is 5'10, weighs 165 pounds and is a right-handed pitcher.
