

Create New Parish Along Winton Road

A new Roman Catholic parish, St. Bartholomew, will be established in Springfield Township. It will draw its members from St. Vivian Church, Finneytown, and Assumption Church, Mt. Healthy.

This and several pastoral changes for the Cincinnati Archdiocese were announced yesterday.

Rev. Francis J. Flanagan, pastor of St. Vincent de Paul Church, was appointed pastor of the new church to be erected on a 20-acre site on the west side of Winton Road, just north of Fleming Road.

No definite time or place for the beginning of services has been set, Father Flanagan said. During the organization period the pastor will reside at St. Vivian rectory, Finneytown.

Succeeding Father Flanagan at St. Vincent de Paul will be Rev. Michael E. Holtzleiter, now assistant at St. Cecilia Church, Oakley. Rev. Philip A. Kesting, former assistant superintendent at St. Rita School for the Deaf, has been assigned to the pastorate of St. Veronica Church, Mt. Carmel, to take the place

of Rev. Joseph M. Wolfer, who recently was appointed to St. Remy Church, Russia, Ohio.

Other clergy changes include Rev. Charles B. Rohrkemper, former chaplain and staff member at Julianne High School, Dayton, to pastor of St. John Fisher Church, Newtown; Rev. John I. Seaman, formerly at the Newtown church, to the Dayton post; Rev. Paul Stolz, former assistant chaplain at Mercy High School, to St. Cecilia Church as assistant; Rev. Francis H. Niehaus, assistant supervisor of Catholic cemeteries, also becomes assistant chaplain at Mother of Mercy High School.

Appointed to the vacant post at St. Rita School was Rev. Stanley Doerger, who has been on the faculty of Elder High School.
