Suspensions Lifted By Bacon Officials On Four Gridders

The four who returned to the football squad after each individual case was thoroughly investigated were Louis Dinkelacker, end; Thomas Sicking, tackle; Raymond Folz, halfback, and William Rethman, end.

The athletic department's statement follows:

"The suspension of four football players has been lifted. This action followed an investigation into the merits of each case and a fulfillment of all requirements by the suspended players. It covers only the four who were temporarily suspended."
